- Pass SPM/SPMV/MCE or equivalent with PASS in Bahasa Malaysia and English and 3 credits in the following subjects:
 - Mathematics or ONE science subject (Biology/Physics/Chemistry/General science); and
 - Any other TWO subjects (including Bahasa Malaysia and/or English):

- Pass SKM Level 3 in Site Safety & Health Supervisor and pass SPM with minimum a credit in 1 subject; **or**
 - Certificate related to Health Sciences with minimum CGPA 2.50
