



Malaysian University English Test (MUET)

The Malaysian University English Test (MUET) is an English language proficiency test that is required for admission to Malaysian public universities, as well as some private universities and colleges. The test is designed to assess the English language proficiency of non-native speakers of English who are seeking to enroll in tertiary education programs in Malaysia.

The MUET is administered by the Malaysian Examinations Council, and test dates are typically scheduled throughout the year. Test takers can register for the MUET at designated test centers and must provide identification and payment of the test fee. Test results are typically released within two months after the test date.

Overall, the MUET is an important test for non-native English speakers who wish to study at Malaysian universities, and it is designed to ensure that they have the necessary English language skills to succeed in their academic studies.

COURSE CONTENT

The MUET consists of four components: Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing. Each component is graded on a band scale of 0 to 6, with 6 being the highest score. The overall band score is the average of the four component scores, rounded to the nearest half-band.
