The central focus of OSH is to assess and manage occupational risks through the application of preventive and protective measures.

- ▶ Mathematics or ONE science subject (Biology/Physics/Chemistry/General science); and Any other TWO subjects (including Bahasa Malaysia and/or English):
- ▶ Pass SKM Level 3 in Site Safety & Health Supervisor and pass SPM with minimum a credit in 1 subject; or Certificate related to Health Sciences with minimum CGPA 2.50 OR
